## UKS2 visit to York Mosque

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to be able to take our Upper Key Stage 2 children (Years 5 & 6) to visit York Mosque on **Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> January**. The children will be able to see a Muslim place of worship first hand and ask members of the mosque questions. This visit will provide pupils with an opportunity to consolidate their R.E. learning and follows on from our recent topic, 'What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?'

### What time are the children going and how?

We will leave school at 1.15pm, after afternoon registration, and the children will arrive back to school approximately 3.10pm. The children will be travelling to the mosque on a coach fully fitted with seat belts.

### What will the children need?

It is important that all children wear their full school uniform and have an appropriate waterproof coat, sturdy footwear and a waterbottle. Children and staff may be required to take their shoes off during the trip before entering carpeted areas of the Mosque. Please ensure that your child is wearing suitable socks, tights or leggings.

### Permissions and costs

When taking children on a visit, out of the local area, we always ask for parental permission. Please visit your ParentPay account to give permission for your child to attend this visit by **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> January**. The visit to the mosque itself is entirely free and the PTA have kindly funded the cost of the coaches.
